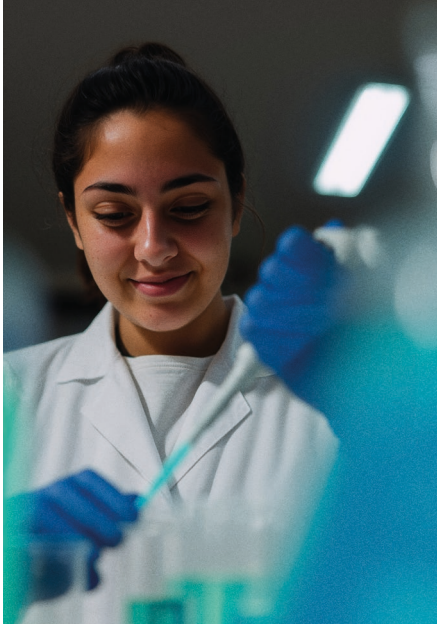

Housing
